1. The meaning "to lift up" is used both literally and figuratively in many phrases. "To lift up the hand"
 - a. "To lift up one's head"
2. The second semantical category, of bearing or carrying, is used especially of bearing the guilt or punishment of sin.
3. The third category stressed the taking away, forgiveness, or pardon of sin, iniquity, and transgression.
